

President's report for 2017 Scrabble NSW AGM

1. The committee met three times during the year – December, March and July
2. Summary of decisions made is always published on website along with minutes of last meeting
3. Now 49 clubs. Gundagai closed and Sanctuary Point opened under Alex Timpano
4. Web page established for Baulkham Hills, excellent newsletter accessible through site
5. Currently 246 members. 63 members receive ATB by email, 58 have nominated to receive ATB by post (at \$5 per year). 50 of 246 members have not yet renewed
6. \$1 per player levy now being paid to CASPA for each tournament. This money goes to funding Nationals and support for national representatives and miscellaneous costs eg website
7. Received 30 sets from Mattel in lieu of monetary funding enjoyed in past. Sets to be handed out to new clubs on basis of one set for every two members supplied. Sanctuary Point received four sets. Members yet to eventuate.
8. Equipment reserves of 92 sets of protils and Scorebook reserve of 5 years (\$1600 expended on scorebooks during year)
